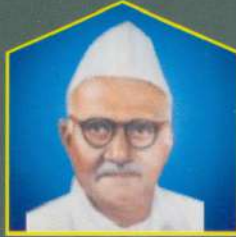

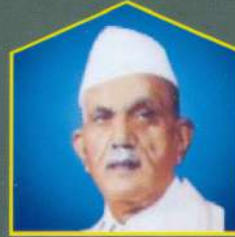

Candidate must have passed standard H.S.C. or equivalent examination from any stream at the first attempt with at least 50 marks in aggregate.

Candidate must have passed Examination of Diploma in Engineering in Computer Engineering (CE)/ Computer Science (CS)/ Information Technology (IT) after 12th Science.
Candidate must have passed all previous semesters examinations with at least 45% marks from Saurashtra University.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR SEM - 1

Prospective candidates are required to fill in the college application form, which can be collected personally from the college on or before the last date prescribed in the admission notice published in the local newspapers.

Before filling the application form, the candidates are advised to carefully go through the prospectus and the application form for the details of the admission process, basis of selection, etc.

Candidates from Boards other than that of Gujarat and candidates from other Universities will have to attach the Provisional Eligibility Certificate, which can be obtained from Saurashtra University, Rajkot. (Candidates seeking P.E.C. will have to go to the Academic Department of Saurashtra University, Kalavad Road, Rajkot with original & photo-copies of (i) S. S. C. Marksheet (ii) H.S.C. Marksheet (iii) School Leaving Certificate (iv) Migration Certificate.)

A candidate seeking admission should submit the photo-copies of the following certificates along with the application form, as applicable

1. S. S. C. Marksheet
2. H. S. C. Marksheet
3. School Leaving Certificate
4. First Attempt Certificate
5. Provisional Eligibility Certificate (only for the candidates from Boards other than Gujarat the Board.)
6. Gap Certificate (if required)
7. Character Certificate
8. S.C./S.T./S.E.B.C. (O.B.C.) Certificate (if applicable)
9. Recent Passport size Photographs : Students (3 copies), Parents (1 copy each)
10. Aadhar Card

Eligible candidates will have to come for a personal interview and counseling with either of their parents on the date and time specified in the merit list. Candidates not remaining present for the counseling as per the schedule will lose their claim for the admission.

Once the admission is granted, the candidate will have to remit the fees in Nawanagar Bank, Shri L.G. Haria School Extension Counter within the given time period. Fees are not Refundable.

Absence with or without leave from the college shall not be an excuse for non payment of fees on the prescribed date. Fee Card should be preserved for future reference.

Caution deposit will be refunded to the students completing three years of study during the month of August of the next academic year on presenting the receipt of the caution money. For those who discontinue their study and leave the college, caution deposit will be refunded within one month of the issue of 'No Objection Certificate'.

The right of granting admission is exclusively reserved by the Management and the Admission Committee.

GENERAL BEHAVIOURAL RULES

As a college community, we believe that good behaviour, endeavour, achievement and contribution in class and around the college should be recognized and rewarded. We also believe that students should take responsibility for their conduct, and when they choose to disobey college rules, they will face sanctions.

College rules apply to all situations where students are in the care of staff. This includes during lectures, in the corridors, at break times, during extra-curricular activities, college outings and games.

When students are allowed to leave the college at the request of parents/guardians, they are the responsibility of their parents/guardians. Such students are representing the college and the college reserves the right to impose sanctions if their behaviour brings the college into disrepute.

Any student who is enrolled at CZMG College is subject to this Code of Behaviour. This is a condition of enrolment.

RESPECT FOR COLLEGE RULES

A student will make the best use of his/her abilities. She/He will respect and obey college rules. This will require attending to such matters as:

Class work

Study and Assignments

Punctuality

Caring for the college environment

All instructions are needed for the smooth, safe and efficient conduct of the work of the college.

RESPECT FOR PROPERTY

A student will respect and care for his/her property. He/ she will also respect and care for the college environment, the property of others and the public property, and take care that they are not damaged or devalued in any way. Students who damage property will be required to pay the cost of making good the damage and will be subject to disciplinary procedures.

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS & RULES

Classrooms (including labs, workshops, games and the library) are our places of work. In order to ensure a positive atmosphere that is conducive to teaching and learning the following behaviours must be adopted.

GENERAL BEHAVIOURAL RULES

BEFORE LECTURES

1. Students are expected to have all appropriate equipment for class.
2. Toilet facilities should be used before 1.00 p.m. and during break times. Disrupting classes for toilet breaks is not recommended.
3. Students may only enter the classroom with the teacher's permission.

START OF LECTURES

1. Students must enter rooms quietly and go to their assigned seats/places.
2. Students must take out books, pens and all necessary equipment for the subject.
3. Students must remain silent while the register is being called.

DURING LECTURES

1. Students are to sit properly on desks and to remain in their seat at all times unless given permission to do otherwise.
2. Students are to work to the best of their ability.
3. Students must respect all members of their class.
4. Students must respect all property.
5. Students must raise their hands if they have a question or wish to respond to a teacher's question.
6. Electronic devices, magazines or other distractions are not allowed in class. They will be confiscated in line with relevant college policy.
7. Students are expected to work sensibly with their classmates. They must not distract or annoy them or the teachers.
8. If students arrive late to class they must knock politely on the door, ask permission to join the class and enter quietly. Arriving late without an acceptable explanation is impolite, disruptive and is in breach of college rules.
9. Eating and chewing are not allowed. Drinking water is only allowed with permission from the teacher.
10. Students must not leave a lecture without permission from a teacher.

END OF LECTURE

1. Students should not begin to pack up before the teacher instructs to.
2. Students must not leave the classroom until instructed by the teacher.

ASSIGNMENTS

1. Assignments, including Practical & Written exercises learning and revision, is given on a regular basis and students are required to complete it neatly and to the best of their ability.
2. Students are required to note all assignments in their assignments book.
3. Parents/guardians are required to ensure that assignments both practical and written is completed.

GENERAL BEHAVIOURAL RULES

MOBILE PHONES AND OTHER ICT DEVICES

1. Mobile phones and other devices must be turned off and put away during all classes and between class periods. The only time they are permitted is at break time.
2. Any student found in breach of this rule will have the complete device including SIM card confiscated for a minimum period of 48 hours.
3. Mobile phones and ICT devices brought to college must be switched off and kept in the student's bag at their own risk.

PERSONAL PROPERTY

1. Students are at all times responsible for their own personal property which should be clearly labeled.
2. Students are not permitted to leave their belongings, including college bags, in the college building after college hours.
3. The college authorities are not responsible for any articles lost or stolen.

SMOKING AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE

1. Smoking (including any nicotine or substance inhalation device) and or substance abuse within college grounds is strictly prohibited and is subject to suspension and to the full rigours of the law.
2. Students in college uniform found smoking within the vicinity of the college entrances and exits are in breach of college rules and will be subject to sanction.

DISCIPLINE ISSUES WILL BE DEALT WITH BY THE SUBJECT TEACHER

1. A verbal warning will give the students the opportunity to change their behaviour.
2. If the behavioural interruptions continue sanctions such as moving students within the classroom, moving students to another classroom under supervision, extra work, will be brought into action by the subject teacher. These sanctions will be recorded in the Student Data Portal.
3. If the student chooses not to change their behaviour the recorded incidents and actions taken will be brought to the attention of the Principal after the subject teacher has exhausted other means of sanction. Records of incidents and actions taken by the subject teacher will be given to the Principal who will invoke the use of support structures where applicable and work with the student and parents/guardians to help the student to change the undesirable behaviour.
4. After college detention is a sanction. Parents will be notified in writing of the date and time of such a detention. Parents/Guardians are responsible for making arrangements for the student to get home after such a detention.
5. Where behavioural interruptions are persistent and the student continues to refuse to adhere to college rules action will be taken.
6. High level disruptive behaviour such as aggressive behaviour, refusal to follow basic instructions, foul language, vandalism of college property, dangerous use of equipment will merit immediate removal from the classroom leading to suspension.

GENERAL BEHAVIOURAL RULES

7. Offensive language or behaviour directed at staff member will result in an immediate 3 day suspension.
8. On returning to college after suspension the parent/guardian and the student must meet with the Principal/Head of the Department before the student returns to classes. The student's behaviour will be monitored on return and they may be subject to additional conditions designed to support them in managing their own behaviour.

SUSPENSION

Suspension is denned as requiring the student to absent himself/herself from the college and college grounds for a specie, limited period of college days. During the period of a suspension, the student retains their place in the college.

Suspension is a sanction designed to address the student's behaviour. It is envisaged that any period of suspension:

- Fighting
- Directed Offensive language
- Smoking in the college grounds or at the entrances
- Theft or Damage to property
- Possession of Weapons
- Threatening behaviour
- Under the influence of un-prescribed mind altering substances (legal or illegal)
- Walking off college premises without permission during class time
- The use or possession of illegal substances or alcohol
- Causing a danger to self or others

LIBRARY RULES

- Library Timings are 8:30 am To 6:00 pm
- Book Transaction Timings are 11:00 am To 6:00 pm
- Students Have to check their i-card status after issued and return books.
- In case Students Loose their Book, they have to return the same book in the library or pay the full price of the book, in one week and along with it they have to pay the due penalty of books also.
- In position of late submission fine will be charged Rs. 5 (Per Day per Book).
- Books can't be issued on others Student's I- card.
- The Reservation system is based on book requirement of availability of book in library. Reservation period of any book is only one week, after that students must renew the same book.
- Previous magazines, CDs, DVDs are also issued on their I-card.
- Magazines, CDs and DVDs are issued other than book transaction.

FINALLY, BUT MOST IMPORTANTLY:

Teachers are in the position of parents/guardians while students are in college. This means in particular that:

There is no excuse for rudeness, disrespect or insolence towards teachers or any other staff member. Any reasonable request from a teacher or other member of staff should be carried out at once and without argument.

Breaking any of these rules will be treated as a **VERY** serious matter.
